ARTICLE 1

SECTION 1. The judicial power of the United States shall be vested in one Supreme Court, and in such inferior Courts as the Congress may from time to time ordain and establish. The Judges, both of the Supreme and inferior Courts, shall hold their Offices during good Behaviour, and shall, at any time during their Continuance in Office, be impeached and removed from Office by a two-thirds vote of both Houses of Congress.

ARTICLE 2

SECTION 1. The executive Power shall be vested in a President of the United States of America. He shall hold his Office during the Term of four Years, and, together with the Vice President, chosen for the same Term, shall be elected in the following Manner: The whole Number of Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors in the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature. No State shall have more Electors than the sum of Senators and Representatives to which it is entitled in the House of Representatives, but the Electors in the most numerous Branch shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors in the least numerous Branch.

ARTICLE 3

SECTION 1. The judicial Power shall extend to all Cases of Law and Equity arising under this Constitution, the Laws of the United States, and Treaties made, or which shall be made, under the Authority of the United States; to all Cases affecting Ambassadors, other public Ministers and Consuls; to all Cases of Admiralty and Maritime Jurisdiction; to Controversies to which the United States may be a Party; to Controversies between two or more States; between a State and Citizens of another State; between Citizens of different States; between Citizens of the same State claiming Lands by Grant or Conveyance from different States or Princes; and between a State, or the Citizens thereof, and foreign States, Princes, or Persons.
